Thank you for considering the eighth annual Aim to Help sponsorship. Benefiting The Crawford Child Advocacy Center (CCAC), this year's event will be held Friday, Sept. 18, 2026 at Great Guns Sporting in Nunn, Colo.

DID YOU KNOW ... 1 in 10 kids will be the victim of sexual abuse before age 18.

DID YOU KNOW ... Since the pandemic, more children in Northern Colorado witnessed domestic violence and homicide than in any prior year we have on record.

DID YOU KNOW ... In 90% of cases, the perpetrator is a trusted adult in the victim's life. In less than 1% of cases, a stranger victimized the child.

For more than 25 years, the CCAC has provided professional forensic interviews in a welcoming, child-friendly setting. Those interviews become key evidence in the prosecution and conviction of perpetrators. The non-offending caregivers of the victim also receive advocacy, information, resources and referrals to help them through the crisis. Additionally, for more than 15 years, the CCAC has led child abuse prevention training for children and adults in northern Colorado. School-based training gives kids the tools to recognize when someone is trying to victimize them and how to respond effectively. Adults learn the signs that a child could be at risk and how to create a safe and protective environment for young people in their care. Moreover, the CCAC has a 19.4% overhead rate, meaning 81 cents of every dollar donated goes to fight child abuse.
